Private Pay/Insurer Pay/EAP

Some Questions to ask your insurer/EAP Provider:

- Which psychological services are covered by your insurance policy or benefit package, and who can provide them (ie. Registered psychotherapist, registered social worker)
 - Whether your plan requires a receipt from an Ontario Registered Psychologist
 - Whether individual or family counselling is covered
- The insurer's procedure for reimbursement (set amount per session, total amount, or portion of fee per visit)
 - Whether you need a physician's referral.
 - The procedure for your reimbursement.
